## HOLIDAYS

If you are closed for an eligible holiday within an authorization period, you may claim the day and be paid as a day the child attends, indicating it is a holiday on attendance records. You may choose to be open on the holiday or close for the holiday on an alternate day within the same year.

  - New Year's Day, January 1
  - Martin Luther King Jr. Day, Third Monday in January
  - Presidents Day, Third Monday in February
  - Memorial Day, Last Monday in May
  - Juneteenth, June 19
  - Independence Day, July 4
  - Labor Day, First Monday in September
  - Veterans Day, November 11
  - Thanksgiving Thursday, the Fourth Thursday in November
  - Native American Heritage Day, the Fourth Friday in November
  - Christmas Day, December 25

## 4.2 **Holidays**

If you are a regular full-time employee work, you will receive a paid day off for

- First Day in January (New Year's Day)
- Third Monday in January (Martin Luther King Jr. Day)
- Third Monday in February (Presidents' Day)
- Last Monday in May (Memorial Day)
- June 19 (Juneteenth)
- July 4 (Independence Day)
- First Monday in September (Labor Day)
- Fourth Thursday in November (Veterans Day)
- Fourth Friday in November (follo... Day/Thanksgiving Day)
- December 25 (Christmas Day)
- Two (2) personal days per year (30)

If an established holiday falls on Saturday, the day will be observed on the preceding Friday. If an established holiday falls on a Sunday, the day will be observed at the Center on the following Monday.

Regular part-time employees are eligible for paid holidays, and variable employees are not eligible.

You must work the regular workdays in order to be eligible for a paid holiday. If you are on excused leave or vacation to receive a paid holiday, you will not be eligible for a paid holiday. If you are on a flexible workweek, you may not take an extra day off during the holiday. However, if the Center requires you to work on the holiday, you must include the established holiday, then the day will be added to your scheduled workweek to "make up" for the holiday. If you are on a flexible workweek, you are required to work 10 hours of work per day, and you must work an extra (2) two hours during the week if you are on a flexible workweek.
